## Mustang II – Back to the Future

Remember the Mustang II? Well, it's coming back. Ford Motor Company has announced its intention to cash in on the mini performance car market to compete with cars such as the Toyota Scion, Subaru WRX, and Mazda Speed3. According to the most recent issue of Motor Trend, Ford has developed a *front-drive*, two seat sportster powered by a turbocharged direct-injected 2.0 liter four cylinder engine to compete in this youth oriented segment. The new Mustang is said to have a carbon fiber body with front and rear aluminum substructures to facilitate weight reduction. The resulting projected 2,200 pounds of curb weight should give the new Pony car an incredible power-to-weight ratio. The authors fully expect this new mini muscle car to compete in and dominate the World Rally Championships. The photo below is an early rendering of the new Mustang. ## Is E15 Gasoline Safe for Your Car ? ? ?

The debate over E15 gasoline was brought to my attention by one of our Club members, Darold Roy. After researching the issue on the Internet, this is what I learned.

E15 is a blend of gasoline that includes 15% ethanol (made mostly from corn). The concern over ethanol in gasoline is that it is believed to be corrosive to rubber and certain metals and can cause damage to your car's fuel system. Of equal importance is the propensity for ethanol to bond with water from the air, and the water can separate out inside the gas tank – and we all know what water in the tank can do. If your car sits for long periods between use (i.e. classic cars in Winter), the moisture settles to the bottom of the tank and can potentially clog in-tank pumps and filters. Damage is also possible in fuel lines, injectors, seals, gaskets, and valve seats – as well at carburetors on older engines.

How did the use of ethanol in gasoline come about? The Federal Clean Air Act was passed to improve air quality standards by, in part, reducing emissions from automobiles. Hence the introduction of ethanol into gasoline that is now seen at gas pumps around the country. Prior to October of last year, the amount of ethanol in gasoline was limited to 10%. However, the Clean Air Act authorized the EPA to grant a waiver of this limit if it can demonstrate that other blends will continue to meet emission standards.

In March, 2009, Growth Energy, a coalition of U.S. ethanol supporters, and 54 ethanol manufactures applied for a waiver to increase the allowable amount of ethanol in gasoline from E10 to E15. The waiver application included data on the impact of E15 on vehicle emissions, fuel system materials, and drivability. Additional data were submitted by the Department of Energy – all claiming that the increase to a blend of E15 was safe for 2001 and newer vehicles.

The president of AAA recently appeared before a House subcommittee to dispute the claims that E15 is a safe fuel and claimed that available research is not sufficient evidence that E15 is safe to use in most vehicles. It is also noteworthy that some automobile companies have announced that they will void warranties for anyone using E15, including BMW, Chrysler, Nissan, Toyota, and Volkswagen. Eight additional automakers (GM, Ford, Honda, Hyundai, Kia, Mazda, Mercedes-Benz, and Volvo) state that E15 does not comply with fuel requirements specified in most owners' manuals and *may* void warranties.

In June of 2012 the EPA approved the use of E15 and a handful of gas stations in Nebraska, Iowa, and Kansas have begun to sell the fuel. According to AAA, the ethanol industry has lobbied hard to increase the amount of ethanol allowed in gasoline as a way to increase sales and help meet emission standards. Soooo, it won't be long before the E15 ethanol blend appears at gas stations in our area unless regulators take immediate action to protect consumers. Until then, critics of the E15 fuel suggest that, if your car is older than 2001, don't fill your tank with E15. *Popular Mechanics* points out that many of the gas stations use blender pumps (a single spout that dispenses all octane). At these stations, you will have to purchase at least 4 gallons of E10 to insure any E15 in the hose is diluted to safe levels in your fuel tank.

In addition to the risk of using E15 in your car, there is an issue with using it in lawnmowers, boats, jet skis, snowmobiles, or ATVs. Again *Popular Mechanics* points out that small engines are not designed to deal with the more corrosive E15 blend and are also at risk.

What to watch for? If and when the E15 is approved for sale nation-wide, gas station fuel pumps must display the following warning:



In the meantime, the battle wages over the use of E15 blended gasoline. The Feds say it is safe for older cars, the AAA and auto companies say it is not until further testing and evaluation takes place. This is an important issue and I recommend that Club members become familiar with the potential risks to your car(s) and other vehicles.
