## Special and Limited Edition Mustangs

The March issue of RMCC's *Mustang Tales* contained an article on the origin of the Mustang nameplate, but how many of us have delved into the number of Special and Limited Edition Mustangs that have been produced from 1964 to the present?

Although most of us are familiar with the more common Mustang models such as Boss, Cobra, GT, Mach-1, Roush, Saleen, Shelby, Steeda and SVO, how many are familiar with Predator Cobra, Twister, Monroe Handler, Sidewinder, Tussy, Warriors in Pink, Branded, or Mustang Colt models, to name a few? In all, there are 79 general categories and no less than 278 different Mustang models produced from the year of the Mustang's introduction through 2013.

Special models have features such as unique interior and exterior trim, distinguishing colors, fender badges or insignia, tape stripes, performance parts, tires, superchargers, and upgraded suspension packages. Many of these models were limited to certain parts of the country as special promotions. For instance, the 1968 Mustang Cardinal Edition was a Virginia and North Carolina "territorial" special. The Lone Star Edition, also called the Bluebonnet Special, was a 1967 territorial special for Texas just as the High Country Special was for Denver and the 1968 California Special was for California.

Other models produced as special regional editions include the Silver Mink Edition (Ohio, Pennsylvania, and West Virginia), the 1968 Dixie Special (Mississippi and Louisiana) and the 2006 Stampede Edition (Texas and Oklahoma).

One can consult the Internet for descriptions of the various Mustang models which also include Bullit, Eleanor, Endura, Grande, Hurst, Shadow, Lady Mustang, Challenger Special, RTR, and Indy Pacesetter to name a few more.

I can think of two excellent reasons to be familiar with the numerous Mustang models. Firstly, with our upcoming MCA show and cars arriving from the various corners of the country, it would certainly enhance the ability of a volunteer judge or assistant judge to perform his or her job by being able to recognize the various models by their fender badges and other components. For instance, is that chrome air cleaner cover part of an actual 1966 Sprint 200, or is it just an after-market addition? Secondly, to a true Mustang enthusiast, it can provide more fun and interest in the hobby if one can walk around a car show and identify the sometimes common, sometimes rare special and limited edition Mustangs.

Other examples of special and limited edition Mustangs include the Limited Edition 400, MPG, Players Special Edition, Rainbow of Colors, AJ Foyt Coyote Edition, Ski Country Special, Ghia, Stallion, Stinger, T-5, Grabber, SSP, Shenandoah, and King Cobra . . . and the list goes on.

## '70 Twister Special Mach 1 Mustang

One of the special edition Mustang models mentioned in Gary Wittmuss's article on special edition Mustangs on page 6 indicates the Twister Mustang was one such car. What I always thought was a rare Mustang model was one of the regional special editions discussed in Gary's article. According to *Mustang Monthly* Ford's Special Promotions Division was approached by American Raceways International (ARI) to build five Mustang Mach 1s and five convertibles to use as pace cars at its five planned NASCAR race tracks around the country. All ten of the Mustangs were to be equipped with a 428 Super Cobra Jet (SCJ) engine mated to a C6 automatic transmission. This request gave birth to the '70 Twister Special Mach 1.



Ford's plan was to build 100 of the Twister Special Mustangs with unique side striping and ARI graphics. As it happened, ARI only completed two of its NASCAR racetracks before filing for bankruptcy, leaving Ford with ten undelivered ARI Mustang pace cars.

Ford didn't want to lose its investment in the Twister project and went looking for a sales district that would take delivery of the Twister Mach 1s. The Kansas sales district decided to take on the cars and sell them as a special edition Mustang in their district. While the Twister Specials were all to be equipped with the 428 Cobra Jet engines, the Dearborn engine plant that produced the 428 didn't have the capacity at the time to produce 100 428 SCJ engines. Rather than scuttle the project, Ford decided to split the number of Twisters in half; half with the 428 SCJ engine, half with a 4-barrel 351 Cleveland engine. All Twister Specials were painted in Grabber Orange paint with side stripes, special rear quarter decals, and a Shaker hood scoop. So, if you see or hear of a Mustang Twister Special Mach 1 you will know that it wasn't a new model of Mustang, but just a special edition Mustang sold in the Kansas City area.
